The SLSO is a leader in music education, offering a broad portfolio of educator-informed resources and initiatives designed to inspire student involvement in music. By creating learning experiences, sharing music in schools, mentoring young musicians, and offering ongoing training to teachers, the SLSO enhances music education throughout the St. Louis region and beyond. In the 2020/2021 season, the SLSO expanded its educational offerings with brand-new virtual programs to support students and teachers in a shifting landscape.
