

For more than 140 years, the St. Louis Symphony Orchestra has been a treasured cultural institution, an education leader, and a musical ambassador for the region. The SLSO is committed to connecting the community, making music accessible to all through live concerts, free events, music education programs, radio broadcasts, and digital content.

In the 2021/2022 season, the SLSO made an impact in the St. Louis region and around the world:

- 174,000+ people experienced the SLSO live at Powell Hall and across the region
- 200+ concerts, free events, education programs, and video projects during the season
- 50+ community partners ranging from universities and musicians from the armed forces in Missouri and Illinois, to houses of worship, schools, social service agencies, nonprofit organizations, and cultural institutions.
- 250,000 students and 1,600+ teachers reached by the SLSO's education programs

- Students and teachers in 48 states and 17 countries connected with SLSO education programs
- 450,000+ people reached on weekly radio broadcasts on St. Louis Public Radio and Classic 107.3 FM.
