The St. Louis Symphony Orchestra is dedicated to making music education accessible to all students and teachers in St. Louis and around the world.

The SLSO is a leader in music education, offering a broad portfolio of educator-informed resources and initiatives designed to inspire student involvement in music.

By creating learning experiences, sharing music in schools, mentoring young musicians, and offering ongoing training to teachers, the SLSO enhances music education throughout the St. Louis region and beyond.

In the 2021/2022 season, the SLSO expanded its educational offerings with brand-new virtual programs to support students and teachers in a shifting landscape. The result: the SLSO directly impacted more than 250,000 students—more than **five times** the number of students reached in a typical year.

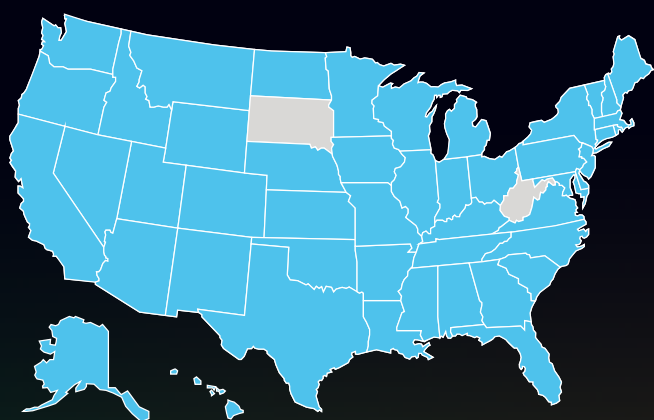

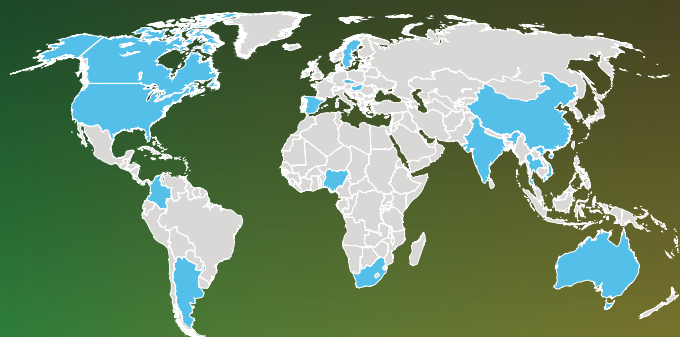
1,200 + **schools participated** in education activities

The SLSO is impacting students and teachers on a world stage. In 2019, 99% of schools the SLSO reached were in MO or IL. Today, only 55% are—with 41% coming from other states and 4% in other countries.
