The SLSO is dedicated to making music education accessible to all students and teachers in St. Louis and beyond, and in 2021 celebrates 100 years of education concerts.

The SLSO is a leader in music education, offering a broad portfolio of educator-informed resources and initiatives designed to inspire student involvement in music. By creating learning experiences, sharing concert programs and music in schools, mentoring young musicians, and offering ongoing training to teachers, the SLSO enhances music education throughout the St. Louis region.

In the 2019/2020 season, the SLSO made an impact on St. Louis students and teachers both in person and online, when the season and school year were disrupted.



- **50,000 Students & teachers** reached both in person and online
- **583 Schools participated** in education activities
- **18 Education & Family concerts**
- **20,000 students** from 365 schools attended concerts at Powell Hall
- **5,000 students attended** Education Concerts for free
- **25 In-school programs** including musician residencies
- **300+ Young musicians** mentored by SLSO musicians in schools and through the Youth Orchestra
- **Instrument Playground Online launched;** a video series with activities to engage students & families
- **2 Sensory-friendly education concerts** hosted in partnership with Special School District
- **300+ teachers participated** in SLSO-created professional development programs
- **1:123 For each teacher** who utilizes SLSO education resources, an average of 123 students are reached
