Norman Huynh conducts the SLSO in performing Nicholas Hooper's score live from Harry Potter and the Half-Blood Prince while the film plays in high-definition on Powell Hall's big screen. Concerts are 7:00pm, Friday and Saturday, October 25-26, and 2:00pm, Sunday, October 27.
