### Repertoire premieres and first performances – 2022/2023 season

Concerts in the 2022/2023 season include the first SLSO performances of more than 27 different works. Nineteen of those works are by 16 composers of today. Music Director Stéphane Denève remains committed to discovering and performing works by living artists that will enter and become mainstays of the orchestral repertoire, as well as developing deep relationships with composers of today.
