#### **GEMMA NEW**

Resident Conductor and Director of the St. Louis Symphony Youth Orchestra Jean L. Rainwater Guest Artist

Sought after for her insightful interpretations and dynamic presence, New Zealand-born conductor Gemma New is currently Music Director of the Hamilton Philharmonic Orchestra in Ontario, Canada, and Resident Conductor of the St. Louis Symphony Orchestra.

In the 2018/2019 Season, New enjoys guest engagements with Los Angeles Chamber Orchestra, CMI Chamber Orchestra of San Antonio, and Santa Fe Pro Musica, as well as the Philharmonic Orchestras of Calgary, Louisiana, and Rochester, the Symphony Orchestras of Charlotte, Detroit, Drummondville, Jacksonville, San Diego, Toronto, Tucson, and Winnipeg, the Florida Orchestra, and the Brandenburgisches Staatsorchester in Germany.

New was a Conducting Fellow at Tanglewood Music Center in the summer of 2018. Previously, she has been Dudamel Conducting Fellow at the Los Angeles Philharmonic, a Conducting Fellow at the Aspen Music Festival, an Ansbacher Fellow at the Salzburger Festspiele, and a Felix Mendelssohn-Bartholdy Fellow with the Leipziger Symphonieorchester.



#### **CAMILLE ZAMORA**

In collaboration with artists ranging from Plácido Domingo to Sting, Camille Zamora has garnered acclaim for her "dramatic and nuanced" (*The New York Times*) interpretations of repertoire ranging from Mozart to tango. She is known for her "dignity and glowing sound" (*The New York Times*) in "luminous, transcendently lyrical" performances (*Opera News*) that "combine gentility and emotional fire" (*The Houston Chronicle*).

Recent seasons have featured performances with Yo-Yo Ma at the U.S. Capitol, her Kennedy Center recital debut, and seven new operatic roles, including the tour de force double-bill of *La voix humaine* and *I Pagliacci*, which was cited as "Favorite Performance of the Year" by *The Columbus Dispatch*. Zamora sang the principal soprano role in Hindemith's *The Long Christmas Dinner* with American Symphony Orchestra at Lincoln Center, the live recording of which topped *The New York Times*' Classical Playlist and was one of *Opera News*' Best Recordings of the Year. Other recent highlights include Granados songs with Yo-Yo Ma and Cristina Pato in the award-winning documentary film *The Music of Strangers*; American Songbook classics by Gershwin, Berlin, Ager, and Arlen with *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert* bandleader Jon Batiste in Los Angeles and New York City for the opening of the new Steinway Hall; and *Twin Spirits: Robert and Clara Schumann* at Lincoln Center and LA's Music Center in collaboration with Joshua Bell, Jeremy Denk, Nathan Gunn, Trudie Styler, and Sting.

Hailed as a leading interpreter of classical Spanish song by NBC Latino and the Congressional Hispanic Caucus, Zamora has performed and recorded principal roles in the zarzuelas *La Verbena de la Paloma, La Revoltosa, Luisa Fernanda* and *La Tabernera del Puerto*. Her performances of classical Spanish repertoire have been heard on five continents, in venues ranging from Carnegie Hall to Zimbabwe's Harare International Festival. *Tango Caliente* and *Sueños de España*, Zamora's concerts of classic Spanish songs arranged for her by Grammy Awardwinner Jeff Tyzik, tours nationally under Tyzik's baton and has been presented with Fort Worth Symphony, Milwaukee Symphony, and Florida Symphony, with upcoming performances with Dallas Symphony, Edmonton Symphony, Rochester Philharmonic, and others in future seasons.



#### **KEVIN MCBETH**

Kevin McBeth was appointed Director of the St. Louis Symphony IN UNISON Chorus in January 2011, and is also the founding Director of the St. Louis Symphony Holiday Festival Chorus. He serves as the Director of Music and Worship at Manchester United Methodist Church in suburban St. Louis. He was recently Adjunct Professor in Choral Music at Webster University.

He has conducted honor, festival, and touring choirs in the United States, Canada, and Great Britain. Previous appointments include assistant conductor of the St. Louis Symphony Chorus and music director of the St. Louis Metro Singers.

With the St. Louis Symphony Orchestra, he has conducted concerts with Oleta Adams, Jennifer Holliday, and Boyz II Men, as well as the July 4th Celebration under the Gateway Arch. McBeth recently led concerts at Carnegie Hall and the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, and is a frequent presenter at regional and national conferences for the American Choral Directors Association. His orchestral conducting credits include performances with the Indianapolis Symphony, Houston Civic Symphony, the New England Symphonic Ensemble, and the Distinguished Concerts Orchestra of New York. Most recently, McBeth conducted a concert tour to Italy, with a performance at St. Peter's Basilica, Vatican City.
