What your bus company & driver need to know about STL Symphony Education Concerts

- 1) Powell Hall is located at 718 N. Grand Blvd., St. Louis, MO 63103
- 2) The bus must be labeled with the school, district, and bus number so it is visible to STL Symphony staff
- 3) We need to arrive 30 minutes before the start of the concert
 - a. For the 9:30am concert that means arriving at 9:00am
 - b. For the 11:00am concert that means arriving at 10:30am
- 4) After dropping students off on the north side of Delmar Blvd., the driver **MUST PARK THE BUS IMMEDIATELY IN THE PARKING LOT BEHIND POWELL HALL** via Compton Ave. *
 - a. Drivers will NOT be able to leave with their bus to get gas
 - b. Drivers will NOT be able to leave with their bus to get food or run errands
 - c. The bus that drops students off at Powell Hall needs to be the same bus that takes them back to school – all buses must remain on the parking lot during the concert
- 5) Bus Drivers are strongly encouraged to stay with their bus or come into Powell Hall for the concert. Drivers may not leave their bus until they have been okayed to do so by STL Symphony staff
 - a. If the driver must leave the bus, the teacher needs to be provided with the driver's cell phone number
 - b. The driver must be back at the bus before the conclusion of the concert
 - i. The 9:30am concert will end at 10:15am
 - ii. The 11:00am concert will end at 11:45am
- 6) Concerts are **ONLY 45 minutes** long
 - a. The 9:30am concert will dismiss at 10:15am
 - b. The 11:00am concert will dismiss at 11:45am

*What you don't know is that during the concert, STL Symphony staff are creating bus locator maps for the teachers so they can quickly and easily locate their bus after the concert. If drivers don't enter the lot immediately after dropping students off on Delmar, they won't be on the map.
